

**Program Name:** DOORWAYS TO CONSTRUCTION PLU (CARPENTRY)

**Program Description:** Students who graduate from the D2C course and wish to further their construction skills in carpentry areas can apply for the D2C+ (carpentry) program. Students will undertake units of competency from Certificate III in Construction (Carpentry). Successful completion of this D2C+ program may reduce the length of an apprenticeship by one or two years, to be negotiated with the Registered Training Organisation and future employer. Students are required to participate in structured workplace learning in industry settings.

**Pathway:** This course leads to Certificate III courses in a range of different trade areas as well as possibilities in School Based and full-time Apprenticeships.

**SACE Credits:** Stage 2, 40 SACE credits

**Course Length:** Semester 1 and 2

**Training Day & Time:** Thursdays 8:45am – 3:15pm

**Commencement Date:** Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2019

**Special Requirements:** The Personal Protective clothing and equipment provided in 2018 must be re-used in 2019. Doorways shirts must be worn and visible at all times while on site. An interview may be required. Where there are more applicants than positions available, selection criteria will take into consideration previous student performance.

Course costs are subject to change due to negotiations with DfE, the RTO and CITB, who currently fund a significant proportion of student training costs in construction (if student is 16 years old at the start of the year). This is also subject to change in 2019
