Program Description: You will gain the practical experience and the theoretical background to undertake work in childcare in a range of early childhood education settings. You will learn in scheduled on-line webex lessons, in the workplace, workshops and independently. On-line learning support is available from our Highly skilled trainers. Assessment is conducted throughout the course in both practical and theoretical aspects, work placement is essential and many assessments will take place as part of a structured work placement.

Teaching: This is a 3-semester course. Student learning is facilitated in small groups on-line with additional sessions at the OAC training centre. Learning materials are accessible anytime online with additional assistance provided online or onsite. Students are able to engage with the course predominantly within their current educational setting. Course completion requires a work placement to be undertaken.

Pathway: Successful completion of the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care may lead to the Certificate IV or Diploma leading to employment as a childcare worker, home care provider, out of school hours worker or nanny.
