Program Description: This course will give you a taste of the child care industry and develop a range of skills that will assist you in both the workplace and relating to children in everyday life. You will work on a range of activities which focus on communication with children, behaviour guidance, occupational health and safety, preparing nutritious foods, basic administration and an introduction to the importance of play for children. Students can gain the full Certificate III after 3 semesters or a partial Certificate within 2 semesters.

Pathway: Completion of the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care provides students with both the theory and the practical experience that underpin workplace skills in the child care industry and various community services organisations.
