

**Program Name:** DOORWAYS TO CONSTRUCTION (General)

**Host School:** Heathfield High School

**Program Description:** This qualification is for students with an interest in the building and construction industry. This program is delivered in conjunction with the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) and it provides pathways to vocations within the building and construction industry such as carpentry, concreting, tiling, painting and decorating, joinery, plastering, bricklaying and demolition. This course combines off the job training, practical work sessions and on-site building experiences.

**Pathway:** This course leads to Certificate III courses in a range of different trade areas as well as School Based Apprenticeships and Full Apprenticeships.

**SACE Credits:** Stage 1, 40 credits

**Course Length:** Terms 1, 2 & 3 (but may extend into Term 4 if necessary to complete the 28 weeks of training e.g. due to public holidays)

**Training Day & Time:** Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday 8:45am – 3:15pm

**Commencement Date:** Week beginning 15<sup>th</sup> February 2018

**Special Requirements:** Submission of a resume, attendance at an interview and successful completion of the interview is a requirement of all applicants. If the number of applicants is higher than the number of positions, selection will be based on the Construction Industry Training Board selection criteria. Students must supply their own steel capped boots, 8m quality tape measure and a box of quality disposable dust masks, all labelled with the student's name. Other personal protective clothing and equipment will be supplied by the course and will include safety glasses, a shirt, riggers gloves and ear muffs.
